A - 2328-600 Panel	2/3 yd	Trim to 21 1/2 x 41 1/2
B - 2328-500 Stripe	2 1/2 yds	Fussy cut 9 1/2" wide strips
C - 2328-307 Coral Blue	3/8 yd	(5) 2 3/4" strips
D - 2328-305 Coral Orchid	1/3 yd	(3) 3" strips sub-cut into 3" squares
E - 2328-203 Seaweed Light Green	1/3 yd	(3) 3" strips sub-cut into 3" squares
F - 2328-117 Seaweed Blue	3/4 yd	(6) 2 3/4" strips cut one strip in half (3) 3" strips sub-cut into 3" squares
G - 2328-105 Seaweed Orchid	3/8 yd	(5) 1 1/2 strips cut one strip in half (3) 3" strips sub-cut into 3" squares
H - 2328-103 Seaweed Seafoam	1 yd	(12) 3" strips sub-cut into 3" squares

Adding first and second borders:

Cut 1 strip of fabric C in half, stitch to the end of 2 C strips. Stitch longer strips to long sides of center panel, stitch shorter strips to top and bottom of panel, miter the corners. Follow the same steps with fabric G 1 1/2" strips

Adding third border - Half Square Triangle Border:

Make half square triangles by drawing a diagonal line on the back of each fabric H 3" square. Stitch fabric H to D, E, F and G 3" squares 1/4" away from the diagonal line to make half square triangle units. Following the photo of the quilt for direction of hst units take one of each pair to make a total of 42 squares for the border. Stitch 12 squares together for right and left sides, stitch 9 for top and bottom border. Stitch to quilt.

Adding fourth border:

Cut 1 F 2 3/4" strip in half, stitch to the ends of 2 strips. Cut to 61" and stitch to right and left sides of quilt. Cut 2 remaining F strips to 41 1/2" and stitch to top and bottom.

Stripe Border:

Finding center of each side pin and stitch each 90" strip to the sides of the quilt. Miter the corners.
